His preferred medium is painting



In his compositions, space is constructed by multiple interwoven layers. Implicitly, supersaturated puzzles give birth to labyrinthine and abstract figures. Colors constructions are sedimented by successive layers and sketch a pictorial language where uncertain figures sometimes emerge between this or that geometric figures. The line often becomes more violent and musical, more rock and roll, as if each of his work is a transcription of a rock concert.

From beneath the clashing of black, red, blue, and green, emerges a little music that suggest intimate and collective narratives. Scattered signs that are sometimes more explicit in his collages: a photograph stuck in a corner, a magazine article or newspaper fragment, "lost media items", Lebanese or Armenian stories.

Sevag Armenian is developing his work since his stay in Paris in the 90s and 2000, where he initiated his work in 1991.

He has participated in a number of collective and personal exhibitions.


